When Robert Preston made the above statement in "THE MUSIC MAN" he was, ofcourse refering to the game of pool. I honestly wish that the SUNWHEELERS "trouble" was as easy to solve as Preston's was. As your president, I feel a great amount of concern for the furture of our club and I surely do not want to "go down in history" as the person who was president when the Sunwheelers died. However, that could very well happen unless things change. I feel pretty sure that there are some members that may not be aware that we have any problems. How could they know when they very seldom attend a rally, let alone host one. The way I see it, we have problems in at least 4 catagories: New Members, Rally Hosts, Participation & Activities. Did you know that only one new family joined our club last year? The Sunwheelers will be 23 years old on the 26th of April this year and I understand that we still have several charter and or long time members on the books. Being aware that as we get older, mother nature isn't always as good to us as we would like and that our activities are sometimes limited. This is a fact of life. Knowing this then, we all need to seek out new & younger families to join our club. The 1995-96 membership roster listed 39 families. Of those 39 only 17 or about 44% hosted a rally last year. That means that 22 or about 56% did not. In 1995, according to the newsletter, we had two "no host" rallies. While the newsletter did not list any "no host" ralleys for 1996, the officers, namely the Powells and the Wilsons, appeared as hosts 4 times. That is just not right or acceptable. While it may be nice to say we are members of the Sunwheelers, unless we participate in the clubs activities, membership is meaningless. Remember the old addage, you only get out of something, what you put into it. Granted, Mary & I have not been members as long as many of you have, but over the years we have been involved in several clubs but this is the first one where the membership has to be called to remind them of the rally (even though the club normally meets on the second weekend of the month and has for years.) and to find out if they were going to attend. The forth problem, as I see it, is Activities. What are the things that our club does that would attract new members and make them want to attend every rally. Other than eating, (we do this real good) fellowship, and the crafts the ladies do, I can't think of anything that would attract and hold new members. That may be one of the reasons why we haven't added many new members. OK-- I've had my say & I've pointed out some things that I feel needs our immediate attention. So here are a few things I would like to see happen to our club in 1997. 15 or

more coaches at each rally. A host or co-hosts signed up for each month. Twenty new members. Someone to be responsible for a planned activity to last at least one hour each Saturday night after dinner. (I understand the club did this at one time). Adopt a project, that we could work on all year, that would give some additional purpose to membership. Adopt the policy of the members calling the host if they are coming (maybe even sending in a deposit) instead of what we do now. Have T-shirts and or jackets with our name & logo. Expand our newsletter to include FMCA / SEA news. I hope that you agree with me, and that you will work with me to make the Sunwheelers the best chapter in Florida .

GENERAL BUSINESS

FROM THE PRES. - HURRICAN EVACUATION.

I had been told that during a hurricane evacuation, there was the possibility that motor homes would not be allowed on the Interstates, but I never knew why. Last week I spoke to Mr. Andy Sikes at the emergency preparedness office who cleared up this matter for me. The answer is simply - WIND. Officials are concerned that high winds could turn motor homes and trailers over, blocking the highways and causing problems for everyone else trying to evacuate. Mr. Sikes suggested that if you were going to evacuate, that you do so as soon as possible after a hurricane WATCH is issued. A watch is issued approximately 36 hours before the hurricane is expected to hit your area. Wind speeds at this time would allow safe travel over bridges, which in Jacksonville is of primary concern for most of us.
