There is some movement in her toes, indicating that some control of her left leg is trying to return, however her left arm is still in paralysis. As of this time she is unable to feed herself and Chris has to help, but we're sure progress will continue there. As things progress there no doubt will be therapy to help her with those chores.

Her sense of humor is returning through all of this, as she has told two of the orderlys that they owe her a quarter each for exposing her during the transfer from the bed to the wheel chair for transport to her daily tests.

For that burning question, she is in the Orange Park Medical Center, (NOT SHANDS as was previously thought.)

Bob and Chris are tired, but that is to be expected. They appreciate all the prayers, and thoughts too, so keep em coming. We'll get through this together.

There is some movement in her toes, indicating that some control of her left leg is trying to return, however her left arm is still in paralysis. As of this time she is unable to feed herself and Chris has to help, but we're sure progress will continue there. As things progress there no doubt will be therapy to help her with those chores.

Her sense of humor is returning through all of this, as she has told two of the orderlys that they owe her a quarter each for exposing her during the transfer from the bed to the wheel chair for transport to her daily tests.

For that burning question, she is in the Orange Park Medical Center, (NOT SHANDS as was previously thought.)

Bob and Chris are tired, but that is to be expected. They appreciate all the prayers, and thoughts too, so keep em coming. We'll get through this together.
